The chair promotes EU's efforts and policies in climate change mitigation as a model for other countries that seek to develop a sustainable lifestyle and eco-system thereby creating an impact in society through its contribution. In furthering this objective, the Chair has carried out teaching activities for UG and PG students, training and capacity building programmes for various stakeholders and various side events for research and awareness on climate change.

About Social Media Campaign through Poster Making Competition

Several major developments have taken place in India to centre stage the need for combating climate change-related adversities. Mountains cover about 27% of the Earth's land surface and host about half of the world's biodiversity hotspots. They provide essential ecosystems, including water resources. However, mountain regions are particularly vulnerable to climate change impacts, threatening both ecosystems and communities. As climate change accelerates, there is an urgent need to raise awareness about these issues, especially among youth who will inherit these challenges. International Mountain Day, observed annually on 11 December, provides an ideal platform to focus attention on these critical matters.

Recognising the importance of climate change and its impact in various aspects and as one of the activities under the Jean Monnet Chair (EUC-LAMP) Project SIU, the JM Chair is organizing a Social Media Campaign through a Making Competition on the Occasion of International Mountain Day on 11th December 2024.

The Campaign unfolds as follows:



The event is a social media campaign Organized on International Mountain Day (11th December 2024). It will feature poster-making competitions centred around six key themes:

1. Mountain Ecosystems and Climate Change
2. Climate Change and Sustainable Farming in Mountain Regions
3. Climate Change and Commercial Mining: Impact on Mountains
4. Biodiversity Loss in Mountain Habitats
5. Mountain Communities: Facing the Brunt of Climate Change
6. Law and Policy Frameworks and Climate Justice in Mountain Regions

Competition Guidelines

1. This Poster Making Competition is organized on the Occasion of International Mountain Day.
2. The Competition will be online on the topic “Mountain Ecosystem”
3. Entries for the competition will be accepted online only through Google Forms.

4. Participants must send a clear photo of the Poster they created.
5. The poster must be half imperial in size (22 inches in length and 15 inches in width).
6. Entries will be accepted only in JPG or PNG format along with a short video clip (minimum of 1 minute and a maximum of 2 minutes) of the participant making the Poster.
7. The use of creative mediums such as digital posters, infographics, etc. to address the themes is encouraged.
8. Drawing, sketching or painting can also be on any paper, drawing paper, or canvas.
9. Digital arts will also be accepted.
10. Only Original Entries will be accepted. Any entry found to be copied or plagiarised by any means will not be considered.
11. Only one entry is permitted per person.
12. The Poster shall be prepared in English Language Only
13. Participants should not include their names and college/Institution name on the poster
14. Each participant shall give their consent to the recording, duplication, and distribution of their submitted entries through follow-up social media campaign.
15. The Poster shall be evaluated on the theme, creativity, Efforts, Scientific Content and Presentation.
16. A jury with internal panellists chooses the winners, and the decision of the jury is final.
17. All participants must accept the decision of the jury.
18. E-certificates will also be issued to all the participants.
19. At its sole discretion, The organiser reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the competition at any time.
