## TRAINING THE TRAINER PROGRAMME ON CLIMATE JUSTICE LAW, GOVERNANCE, MANAGEMENT AND POLICY

In 2022, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) Pune has been awarded with Jean Monnet Chair on EU Climate Justice Law, Governance, Management and Policy (EUC-LAMP) (Co-funded by the EU) and Dr. Shashikala Gurpur has been conferred with the honour to hold the Chair as the Professor.

Under the prestigious Jean Monnet Chair (EUC-LAMP) the 'Training the Trainers programme on Climate Justice Law, Governance, Management, and Policy' was organised on the 20th January 2024 from 9.30 am to 6:30 pm to impart training to over 100 participants including various stakeholders like NGOs, Researchers, Youth, Academicians, Judges, and Barefoot Advocates.

The programme started with the lighting of lamp by the dignitaries followed by the welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Shashikala Gurpur Fulbright Scholar, Director, Symbiosis Law School, Pune, Dean, Faculty of Law, Symbiosis International (Deemed University), Jean Monnet Chair Professor (EUC-LAMP Co-funded by EU), She discussed the array of major and minor environmental projects that the institution has undertaken as a part of the JM chair deliverables. She highlighted that the training programme had been designed to create awareness and disseminate information regarding climate change policies and discuss ways to implement them in our daily lives. She mentioned that the trainees of today would be the trainers of tomorrow. She emphasized upon the contributions of Dr. S.B. Majumdar, Chancellor of the Symbiosis International University, for instilling the idea of simplicity, green lives, sensitivity to all living beings, and most importantly, for the institution's motto of *'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam'* to foster the idea of living in harmony with all those who share a cosmos with us, as core values of the institution. Dr. Gurpur felicitated the esteemed dignitaries Mr. Shivam Singh, CEO and Founder of ExploreiT, National Coordinator for Youth, Climate Reality Project India, Mr. Sathya Natrajan, Director for Community Outreach at ExploreiT, Lead Volunteer at Adar Poonawala Clean City and Mr. Lelith Daniel, Assistant Professor, Symbiosis Community Outreach

During the training session, the trainees participated in activity-based learning and with the help of sketching presented their ideas on environmental issues and climate justice. The activity-based learning was followed by a session by Mr. Claude Alvares renowned Environmental Activist, Director, Goa Foundation Editor, Other India Press, he discussed his life experiences to explain how to start an effective movement for environmental issues. Thereafter, Dr. Prakash Rao Dy. Director and Head - Energy & Environment Dept. at Symbiosis Institute of International Business (SIIB), Head, Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability, SIU discussed about Climate change and sustainability management perspectives in building a climate-resilient future. His address was followed by Dr. Manikprabhu Dhanorkar, Associate Professor and Deputy Head, Symbiosis Centre for Waste Resource Management, SIU, he highlighted the best Practices of Waste segregation.
