Workshop on “*Combating Anti-Competitive Practices and the Role of the Competition Commission of India*” on 24th February, 2025 (Monday) by Symbiosis Law School, Pune, SIU at 2:00-4:00 PM.

A Workshop on "*Combating Anti-Competitive Practices and the Role of the Competition Commission of India*" is scheduled on February 24, 2025 (Monday), in Symbiosis Law School, Pune (SLS-P), a constituent of Symbiosis International (Deemed University), bringing in the eminent resource speaker as Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Director (western region), Competition Commission of India.

The workshop intends to delve into two core themes: discussing the complexities of anti-competitive practices, ranging from cartel formation, price-fixing, abuse of dominance, to unfair trade practices that restrict market access for new players, how such practices harm consumer welfare, stifle innovation, and distort market dynamics and the role of the Competition Commission of India (CCI) as the watchdog of the Indian market, in curbing these detrimental practices and enforcing competition law ensuring a level playing field for all market participants in the country.
